We are very excited to let you know that Year 4 children will have the opportunity to visit Tamarisk Farm in West Bexington on Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> May, to tie in with our Sow, Grow Farm topic. Thanks to the Edible Garden team, this will be entirely free of charge, including travel and a healthy lunch using local produce created by a professional local caterer who has donated her time. Activities will be finalised next week but we'll be learning about how this long-established organic farm on the Dorset coast is managed, growing crops, managing livestock and where the food that they grow is sold. There will be a chance to meet some animals!

As mentioned, lunch will be provided free of charge. The children have a choice of sandwich, along with crisps, cake, a piece of fruit and a drink. Gluten and dairy intolerances can be accommodated and the meal will be nutfree. For any other intolerances, we suggest children bring their own sandwich to suit their needs. We would be grateful if you could indicate your child's preference below and return the consent form to the office by Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> April so we can pass this information to the caterer.

We will confirm details of clothing and what children should bring closer to the time, but if you have any further questions in the mean time, please speak to us after school or drop an email to the office.
